## NITs

### Characteristics

- The Scrooges of poker
- Risk Adverse
- Only play very good hands pre-flop
- Usually only get involved in big pots post-flop with big hands
- Typically play fit or fold post flop

### HUD Stats

- **VPIP:** Very Low
- **PFR:** Very Low
- **CBET:** Average
- **Fold to CBET:** High
- **3BET:** Low
- **Fold to 3BET:** High
- **VPIP/PFR Examples**
  - Full Ring: 10/8
  - 6-Max: 15/12

## TAGs

### Characteristics

- The typical good player
- Tight aggressive opponent
- Very difficult to play against
- Competent in most areas
- Capable of bluffing
- May have leaks

### HUD Stats

- **VPIP:** Low
- **PFR:** Low
- **CBET:** High
- **Fold to CBET:** Average
- **3BET:** High
- **Fold to 3BET:** Average

### • VPIP/PFR Examples

- Full Ring: 15/12
- 6-Max: 21/18

## LAGs

### Characteristics

- Loose aggressive opponent
- The typical good player
- Usually biggest winners
- Very difficult to play against
- Competent in most areas
- Bluffs often
- Fight for many pots
- Fearless opponents
- Will put endless pressure on you

### HUD Stats

- **VPIP:** Medium
- **PFR:** Medium
- **CBET:** High
- **Fold to CBET:** Average
- **3BET:** High
- **Fold to 3BET:** Low

### • VPIP/PFR Examples

- Full Ring: 20/18
- 6-Max: 30/28
